

Magdalene College MCR Kayak user Protocol v2 (2023)

Safety and maintenance guidelines for the use of the MCR kayak

These provisions relate specifically to the use of the kayak.

MCR Kayak - Users must book using the online booking system via the MCR.

By using the MCR kayak you affirm to the following safety and maintenance guidelines:

- 1. You have to book the kayak through the **online booking system** before use.
- 2. You have an **active membership of the MCR fleet** (you have paid within the last year).
- 3. You are able to swim at least 50 consecutive meters.
- 4. You wear a life jacket at all times when on the water.
- 5. A maximum of two people are allowed in the kayak.
- 6. Consumption of alcohol is prohibited before and while using the kayak.
- 7. The kayak can be used throughout the whole year between 08:00am sunset.
- 8. During the colder months of the year (December to February) for reasons of safety we encourage to stay with the kayak between Jesus lock and Mill Pond
- 9. Once finished, please remove all personal items and eventual trash from the kayak, return the kayak back to its storage unit, **make sure the kayak is locked up**, and place the life jacket within the designated container. **Return the key for the MCR storage unit to Porters Lodge.**
- 10. Any accidents or incidents must be reported to the Porters Lodge and the corresponding MCR officers (see below) immediately.
